



4 FAST FACTS ON BEAR HOUNDING

1

Hounds running at large are a threat to not only bears, but also to non-targeted animals like deer fawns.

2

Hounders are often miles away from their hounds and have no control over them.

3

Hounds chase a bear for miles, separating mothers from cubs, until the exhausted animal either climbs a tree (and is often shot) or a fight may ensue on the ground.

4

Hounding violates landowner rights and places people, their property and their animals in danger.
